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Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) is located at K10N & K10S wards. It provides services for premature babies and babies below 1 month. There are various emergency monitoring, treatment & care. When the baby's condition becomes stable, he/she will be transferred to the Special Care Baby Unit or referring hospital for further treatment and care.

The multidisciplinary team comprises of Paediatricians, Surgeons, Nurses, Allied Health and supporting staff.

We aim to provide comprehensive treatment and quality care to patients.

#### Admission Information \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*

On admission, please provide baby's immunization card, birth certificate if available, and mother's ID card.

Please inform the doctors for any medication being used at home, and history of drug allergy.

Please do not give any medication to baby without medical approval.

For breast feed mother, please tell the paediatrician for any kind of drug that you are taking.

Please bring along toiletries such as tissue paper, bath lotion and diapers for your baby. You may also bring in a music box, or cassette tapes (labeled with your baby's name). The hospital will not take any responsibility for lost of personal belongings.

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We encourage breast-feeding. For any reasons that your baby cannot feed by breast milk, we will provide formula milk to him / her.

Breast Feeding Room is available in K10N.

\*Special arrangement for critically ill baby.

\*For baby who stays in the ward over 1 month, parents can bring grandparents to visit from 4pm to 6pm during weekends and public holidays. One visitor at each time and must be accompanied by father or mother. Please arrange with nursing staff before visit.

★ Please turn off your mobile phone before entering the ward to avoid interference with the medical equipment.

#### To ensure patient safety:

★Please lock the incubator doors properly and do not walk around in ward area when holding the baby.

★ Please perform hand hygiene inside the cubicle before and after visiting your baby.

★ Please approach nurses for patient's information; do not read from the medical records.

★ Please do not tamper with any of the medical equipment.

★ Please do not smoke, eat or drink in the ward.

★ Please do not leave your handbags & valuables unattended.

★ Please do not leave any valuables or bulky items in the hospital.

Doctor's round time

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Paediatrician's round – 9:00am & 4:30pm Surgeon's round – 8:00am & 6:00pm Saturday, Sunday & PH – 8:30am

You are requested to leave the ward during doctors' round, or when there is a medical / nursing procedure.

★ If you wish to discuss with the doctor about the progress of your baby, please ask the nurse to arrange an appointment for you.

★ If you have special reasons & cannot visit during the visiting hours, you may call the NICU hotline (8A-8P)

★To ensure patient's confidentiality, please note that we would check your ID no./ passport no. for every call you make to the hotline.

* Please inform the doctor in charge if you need an admission / sick leave certificate

★ Please approach nurses for information if you need a medical report. A fee will be charged.
